

Linden Park Primary School Uniform Code



Our students are proud to be part of the Linden Park Primary School community. Our uniform is designed to be smart and distinctive as well as comfortable and functional for students.

Students are required to wear items on the Uniform Code list, which are in the school colours of maroon, grey and white. The wearing of clothing with the school logo is strongly encouraged and other logos are not acceptable. All items purchased outside our uniform shop are required to comply with the Uniform Code. Students are required to comply with the School Uniform Code at school and when representing the School at other venues.

Exemptions: from wearing the uniform can be sought from the Principal on the following grounds: religious (clothing or adornments, unless the item poses an unacceptable risk to safety); cultural or ethnic; new students (reasonable time to purchase); itinerant students; financial hardship; medical or family sickness; student casual days and special events.

The Uniform Shop endeavours to stock good quality items at reasonable prices that comply with the Uniform Code. The opening hours are listed on our website https://lindenpkr7.sa.edu.au/parent-information/uniform-shop/ and is next to the front office. Uniform items can also be purchased via the Qkr app and these items will be delivered to your child's classroom. If you would like your child/children to visit the shop alone, our helpful staff at the shop will assist. The Uniform Shop has a small selection of second-hand uniforms available for purchase. We gratefully accept any uniform donations.

Uniform items available from the Uniform Shop:

- ✓ Maroon long-sleeved polo shirt with logo
- ✓ Year 6 commemorative polo shirt
- ✓ White skivvy (to wear under tunic or polo)
- ✓ Maroon polar fleece jacket with logo
- ✓ Maroon polar fleece vest with logo

- ✓ Maroon tracksuit jacket with logo
- ✓ Maroon wet weather jacket
- ✓ Maroon skort
- ✓ Maroon rugby shorts
- ✓ Grey shorts
- ✓ Maroon bootleg pant
- ✓ Maroon trackpant

Other acceptable items (not available at the Uniform Shop):

- ✓ White or grey socks
- ✓ Black or grey bike shorts or leggings (as undergarments only; to wear under tunic/dress, skirt or shorts)
- ✓ White long-sleeved t-shirt (under tunic or polo)

<u>Hats:</u> Linden Park Primary School is a SunSmart school and therefore students must wear a maroon broad brimmed, bucket or legionnaire's style hat whilst outside on school grounds and when representing our school at other outdoor venues. Hats must be worn from 1st September until the 30th April and when the UV index is 3 and above at other times of the year.

<u>Footwear:</u> Shoes worn to school need to be appropriate for the range of activities students undertake at school e.g. sports shoes, black enclosed school shoes, or sandals. Thongs and slip-on shoes are not to be worn for safety reasons; no shoes with lights or wheels. No gumboots/wellington boots at school.

Sports Uniforms: Some out of school hours sports require uniforms specific to the sport. Please refer to instructions from the Out of School Hours Sports Co-ordinator.

Some sport uniform items are available from the Uniform Shop include:

- ✓ Black football and soccer shorts
- Maroon football and soccer socks

<u>SportSA Jumpers:</u> Students who have represented the school at district level or who represented the school at a level or sport to be eligible for a SportsSA jumper are permitted to wear the SportsSA jumper relevant to their sport weekly on Fridays, subject to the Code. Eligibility extends to the year of representation eg the year they represented the district/school in the sport. They are required to wear a LPPS school jumper Monday to Thursday and when they are on a school excursion for reasons of school identify and safety.

<u>School Bags:</u> It is recommended that students use the LPPS school bag as it provides plenty of storage for all student needs.

<u>Communication Bag:</u> Reception students will receive a communication bag at the commencement of Term 1. They are recommended to bring home safely all notes and homework readers.

<u>Jewellery:</u> Studs or sleepers only; no more than two earrings per ear. No jewellery unless for religious or cultural reasons (see above exemptions). Students are asked to not wear nail polish, makeup and visible stick on tattoos to school.

<u>Hair:</u> Students are requested to only use bright hair accessories on special occasions (eg. Sports Day). For safety reasons, long hair is to be tied back, and hair accessories should be small and in school colours. Large hair accessories (eg. JoJo bows) are not permitted. Scrunchies made from our uniform cloth are available from the Uniform shop.
