

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK (WWCC)

Primary School

Parents/guardians require a Working with Children Check when volunteering involves close personal contact (eg, helping a child get dressed, or go to the toilet) with a child other than your own child. https://www.sa.gov.au/topics/rights-and-law/rights-and-responsibilities/screening-checks/screening-wwcc/who-needs-a-working-with-children-check. WWCCs are valid for five years and a WWCC is free if only used for volunteering purposes.

You can apply through the school or you can apply online directly.
